CASA-15th Judicial Circuit is a nonprofit, volunteer-based organization that advocates for abused and neglected children within the Juvenile Court system. We recruit, screen, train and support volunteers from the community are appointed by a judge to speak for the best interests of children in the abuse and neglect court. Our obligation is to ensure that the children we are appointed to will be visited at least monthly, and that their needs, desires and circumstances will be reported to the court at every scheduled hearing. The Court Appointed Special Advocate/Guardian Ad Litem (CASA/GAL) will be the consistent person in the child's life.

We are looking for an Advocate Supervisor to provide case management supervision to our community volunteers. In addition, this position will provide recruitment and training to new volunteers. Supervisors are responsible for maintaining agency relationships as well as relationships with all the parties in the case. This full-time time position, based in Freeport, IL, is flexible with some periods of time that will require more time than others. This role will work closely with the Executive Director, other staff, volunteers and the general community to support CASA's mission to advocate for abused and neglected children.

A high school diploma or GED is required, college graduate and/or industry related education or experience is preferred.
